

Achievements

- Our students reached out to help and thank others in local, national, and international communities. During the school year, St. Mary School students collected animal items for the Gloucester County Animal Shelter, hats, gloves and socks for local shelters, and food for the Our Lady of Peace Parish Thanksgiving Drive.
- St. Mary School participated in The Butterfly Project. This was a global project collecting 1.5 million butterflies to honor the lost children of the Holocaust. Former seventh-grade teacher, Mrs. Tina Casale, collected 420 hand-made butterflies from the students in preschool to eighth grade. These butterflies will hang in the Holocaust Exhibit in The Houston Museum in Texas. St. Mary's students learned through this experience compassion, tolerance and respect.
- St. Mary School World Crusader Club headed a number of UNICEF community projects during the 2010-2011 school year which helped raise money for children in need of medical supplies, educational materials, clean water, and nutritional support all over the world. These programs include: K.I.N.D. (Kids in Need of Desks) to help purchase desks for needy school children in Malawi and the Tap Project to help provide clean water for millions of children globally.
- St. Mary School "actors" and members of the stage crew performed Disney's Alice in Wonderland Jr. This is the sixth musical the Performing Arts Club has presented since it began in 2006.
- Members of the St. Mary School band played at the Camden Riversharks game in May.
- The Chess Club participated in the Ambassador Christian Annual Chess Tournament. Our club members in the different age categories achieved many first, second, third place and honorable mention medals.

- St. Mary School was awarded accreditation by the Middle States Association of Colleges and Schools. St. Mary School was one of approximately 200 schools so honored.
- St. Mary School had a composite score of 86% in the IOWA Test of Basic Skills. This means that St. Mary School scored better than 86% of the other schools taking the same test at the same time.
- St. Mary School graduated 53 students in June. These students attend a variety of high schools. They include: Paul VI, St. Joseph's, Bishop Eustace, St. Augustine Prep, Our Lady of Mercy Academy, Gloucester Catholic, Gloucester County Institute of Technology, Camden County Institute of Technology, Williamstown High School, Washington Twp. High School and Delsea Regional High School.
- Eighth grader Jordyn Cohen was selected the recipient of the Paul VI High School's Montini Scholarship.
- Eighth grader Matthew Parr was the recipient of the Alumni Golf Tournament Scholarship from Gloucester Catholic High School.
- Eighth grader Alexandra DiStefano was selected the recipient of the Dominican Scholarship from Gloucester Catholic High School.
- Eighth grader Kellie Underwood was selected by the Office of Black Catholic Ministry Essay Committee as the Diocesan First Place Winner of a \$200 savings bond for her essay "In What Ways Will Your Faith Impact Your Decision in Choosing a Career Goal?"



- The varsity cheerleading team has won the GCCAL Championship for the past three years.
- The JV Cheerleading team had back-to-back undefeated competition seasons and won first place in the GCCAL JV Division.
- The varsity girls volleyball team placed fourth out of 13 teams in the South Jersey Girls Volleyball League.
- The varsity boys baseball team won BGSS Baseball Conference Championship against Pine Hill 12-2.
- The JV soccer team was undefeated during the 2010 season.
- The Varsity soccer team played in the GCCAL division championship at St. Augustine Prep.
- In track, the St. Mary's boys and girls relay teams qualified for the Penn Relays. The boys team came in second place taking home a silver medal.
- The boys track team also won the track Divisionals Meet.
- Also in track, St. Mary School 2011 graduate, Paul Uffen, won four gold medals in the 100m, 200m, long jump and 4x100 relay at the Meet of Champions.
