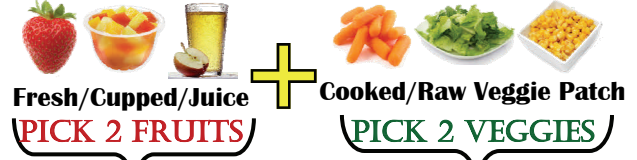

In a separate pot dissolve sugar into 1.5 c milk on low heat. Add rice to mixture & heat over Med heat for 15-20 min. Combine 1/2 c milk in a measuring cup, egg, vanilla & spices. Pour the measuring cup mixture into the rice mixture and fold in butter. Cover with plastic wrap and serve warm or chilled.

Office of the School Nurse

Below are some guidelines to follow if your child is sick or sent home from school with an illness. Hopefully, if everyone follows the guidelines we can reduce the spread of any germs and your child will be healthy and ready to grow and learn.

WHEN SHOULD I KEEP MY CHILD HOME FROM SCHOOL?

Every day we have children who are absent or sent home from school with various illnesses. Please remember to follow these guidelines in determining when your child is healthy enough to return to school.

- Students should be **“fever-free”** (less than 100.0 F) for a **full 24 hours** before returning to school. This is fever-free **without** the aid of medication.
- Students should be able to tolerate foods/fluids for a **full 24 hours** following a “stomach bug” with vomiting and/or diarrhea and be **symptom free for 24 hours**. **If your child is vomiting one day, keep them home the next day.**
- Students diagnosed with a strep infection should have **24 hours** of antibiotic and should feel well before returning to school.

The common cold: Since transmission of the common cold typically occurs before symptoms develop, it is not necessary to exclude children with a mild disease. However, a child with a **fever, fatigue, constant coughing, lack of appetite or inability to concentrate** on school activities should be allowed to remain home.

Having sick children come to school only to be sent home shortly after arrival makes the child uncomfortable, inconveniences the parent, and exposes other children in the school who then become sick. For now, stay healthy. Take some time to observe your child to make sure they are free from these nasty germs that are going around. When children feel well and are healthy, they enjoy school more and learn better.

Plenty of rest, a nutritious diet and **good hand washing** are our best defenses against spreading illness. Please reinforce this with your children. Thank you.

All required documentation must be submitted for the application to be processed. **Only completed applications will be considered.** It is the responsibility of the family to supply all necessary paperwork.

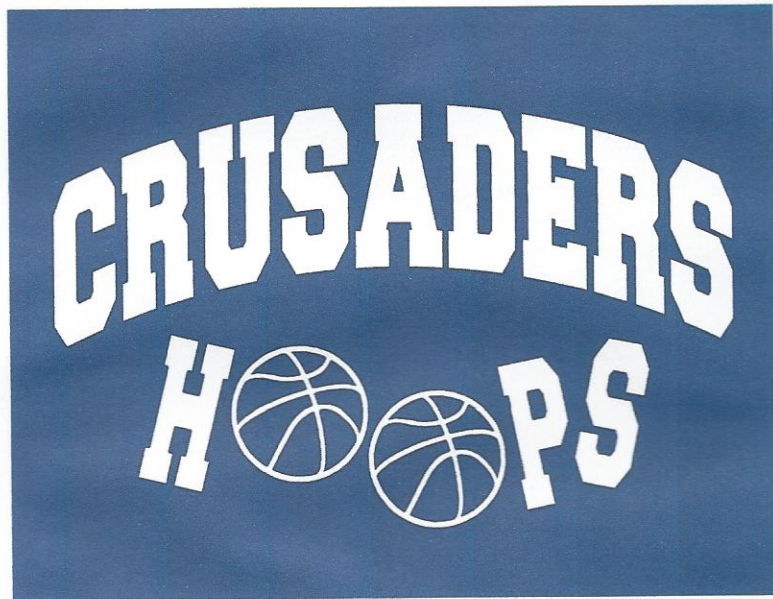

Emergency closings are an inevitable part of life in the Northeast due to inclement weather. Therefore, we need to explain our procedures.

EARLY MORNING SNOW/ICE CLOSINGS...Local transportation authorities determine when their buses can operate safely. Therefore, when Monroe Township public schools are not open due to inclement weather, St. Mary School will also be closed. You will receive a SchoolReach message with the information. **You may also call the school office at 856-629-6190 or check the school website at www.smarys.org to receive notification of the school closing.** Our code number is 811 – Monroe Township. Information will also be available on local television stations. Only Monroe Township Schools will be announced, St. Mary School will not be identified. **If school is cancelled due to the weather, all afterschool activities will be cancelled as well.**

Monroe Township occasionally announces a 2-hour delay. If that is the case, supervision at St. Mary School will not be available until 10:00 a.m. School will begin at 10:15 a.m.

Since St. Mary School has students from outside the Monroe Township School District, it is important to have the following information:

Code numbers for: **Franklin Township - #812 Washington Township - #803**
 Winslow Township - #572 Clayton - #809

If St. Mary School is open and the Winslow Township, Franklin Township, Washington Township and/or Clayton schools are closed, it is the responsibility of the parents to transport students to and from St. Mary School. You may also choose to keep these children home from school for that day, if transportation is a problem. These students will be marked “absent” because they are not here for the day.

EMERGENCY CLOSINGS AFTER THE CHILDREN ARE IN SCHOOL. If we receive word that the school districts will be sending the buses for an unscheduled early dismissal due to dangerous driving weather – we need to cooperate with their request. **In this event**, parents will receive a SchoolReach message. In the beginning of the school year, we requested information from you regarding transportation plans in case of an emergency early dismissal. These are the plans that we will direct the children to follow. **PLEASE DISCUSS THIS PLAN WITH YOUR CHILD/CHILDREN.**

IF SCHOOL CLOSSES EARLY, DUE TO WEATHER OR AN EMERGENCY, AFTER SCHOOL CARE WILL NOT BE AVAILABLE.

If you use the shopwithscrip.com option and add the Presto Pay feature as well, you would be able to download any of the scrip items that are available as a Scripnow purchase and they will be sent to your email almost immediately, so that you can use those items as soon as you need them. The Office of Child and Youth Protection is announcing CAP (Child Assault Prevention) sessions. CAP is the safe environment training program for adults who have regular contact with minors. Attendance is required in order to comply with the USCCB's *Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People*. The policy of the Diocese of Camden is that adults will attend CAP once every five years.

CAP 1 teaches attendees to recognize child abuse and neglect and how to report to the proper authorities. Adults are taught that children have the right to be safe, strong and free. CAP 1 is for new volunteers and employees.

CAP 2 is called *No More Bullies, No More Victims* and is a workshop addressing bullying awareness and bullying prevention. Cyber-bullying is also presented.

CAP 3 is called *Cyber-Empowerment* and is a workshop which promotes adults understanding of cyber activity of youth while teaching them realistic ways to help children keep their own rights and guard the rights of others in the cyber-sphere.

Each presentation is 90 minutes.

Adults who are new employees or volunteers should attend CAP 1 before attending CAP 2 or CAP 3. After five years, adults have the option of attending CAP 1 or 2 again if they prefer.

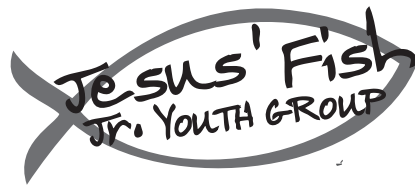
