Dear Parents and Guardians,

Another wonderful year has gone by! Thanks to your support and the guidance of the teachers, our students have grown academically and have grown in their faith as well. Thursday we end our school year with a prayer service followed by an academic assembly. We will begin at 9AM in the church.

Congratulations to our kindergarten and preschool students who celebrated their closing ceremonies last week. What a treat to see what they have learned throughout the year!

The summer months will be filled with work preparing for the new school year. To enhance our academics we continue to update our textbook series. Throughout the summer, several of our teachers will be working in conjunction with other teachers in the diocese on the formation of an updated Language Arts curriculum. Painting and cleaning will take place in our building after the carnival!

Required paperwork for students to participate in our sports program can be found on the front page of our website. Athletes must turn in mandatory documents in order to practice/play. Paperwork includes a required physical as well as a sign off sheet regarding the pamphlet titled *Sudden Cardiac Death*. Paperwork must be renewed for each school year. All coaches must be fingerprinted, CAP certified, and trained in the use of EPI Pens and the AED.

A few updates for next year:

- Students will have the option of either wearing the white, blue or gray SMS Spiritwear T-shirt for gym classes or the navy Crusader T-shirt.
- Girls in grades 6, 7 and 8 will be required to wear black, navy or white tights with their skort all year. They can be purchased at a store of your choice. We expect the skort to be fingertip length. If you are in need of uniforms pieces, we will have a Uniform Exchange on Tuesday, July 28th from 5:00 pm – 7:00 pm in classroom K2 and Flynn and O'Hara will be here on Wednesday, July 29th from 10:00 am – 2:00 pm in classrooms K1 & K2.
- We are also planning to have all after school activities enter and exit the gym through side door facing the new parking from 3:00 pm-5:30 pm. The main doors of the gym will be for After Care pick up only during that time. More information will follow.
- Our school emergency notification system SchoolReach was acquired by a new company named School Messenger. More information will follow.

Our summer newsletter will be posted in the beginning of August. This will contain information regarding the first few weeks of school. Class lists will be available at the end of summer. Please know that our teachers take much time in determining class placement for each student. Requests have been considered but are not

guaranteed. As mentioned in my letter last week, requests for class placement will no longer be accepted. Our teachers will be sending home math practice work for the summer. Please encourage your child to use the textbook online. There are a variety of games that review basic math facts (addition, subtraction, multiplication and division). The book also offers a math tutor to practice concepts. This will ensure that your child is ready for the new school year!

The faculty and staff wish you a peaceful, safe summer. You will be remembered in our prayers. Hope to see you at the carnival!

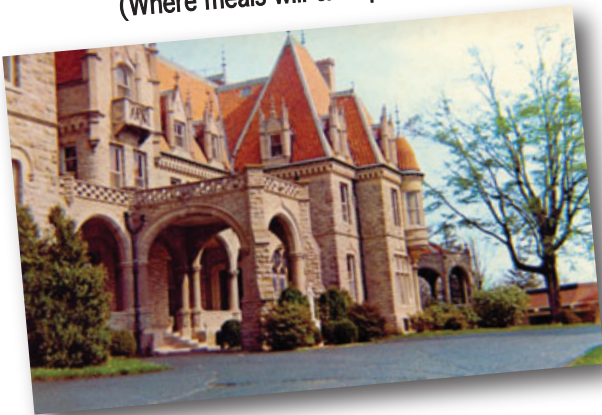
*Please note June 21st is Father's Day. The retreat will end after Mass on Sunday morning approximately at 11:30am.
