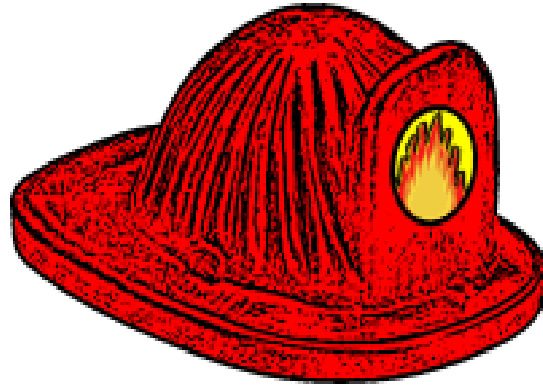

On behalf of the SMS School Board we are happy to continue with the 4th Annual St. Mary's Science Exhibit. We are inviting our students to participate in a project based activity that supports the educational goals of the school. Science, technology, and research are three key areas that our students continue to learn more about on a day to day basis and will remain at the forefront of their schooling as they move well beyond St. Mary's School. This will prove to be exciting an opportunity for all of our students!

We are opening this opportunity up to the students in two ways. Our K-3 students will be completing their Science Exhibit entry during the school day and will submit one per class to display on the night of the Exhibit. For students in Grades 4-8, we are asking any interested students to sign up to complete an individual project or two students may work together who are in the same grade level. This is *optional* and only students wishing to participate should sign up. The Science Exhibit will be held the evening of **Wednesday, April 11, 2018** in Assumption Hall. Students who are interested in participating will need to submit their projects on the morning of **Tuesday, April 10, 2018**. Please sign and return the permission slip below by **Wednesday, January 31, 2018** if your child is interested in participating.

Below is some helpful information for 4th-8th grade students who are interested in participating. There will be more information/guidance to come via the Communication Folder.

- Projects should be driven by student interest.
- All projects will need to be presented using the scientific method.
- All projects will need to be displayed on a presentation board that you can purchase at any local office supply store.
- The 4th-8th grade students will be provided with feedback on their projects by judges who work in the fields of Science and Technology.

We can be sure that we love God's children when we love God and do what He has commanded. 1 John 5:2

The Office of Child and Youth Protection is announcing CAP (Child Assault Prevention) sessions. CAP is the safe environment training program for adults who have regular contact with minors. Attendance is required in order to comply with the USCCB's *Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People*. The policy of the Diocese of Camden is that adults will attend CAP once every five years.

CAP 1 teaches attendees to **recognize child abuse and neglect** and how to report to the proper authorities. Adults are taught that children have the right to be safe, strong and free. CAP 1 is for new volunteers and employees.

CAP 2 is called **CAP's Bullying Prevention Program** and is a workshop addressing bullying awareness and bullying prevention. Cyber-bullying is also presented.

CAP 3 is called **Cyber-Empowerment** and is a workshop which promotes adults understanding of cyber activity of youth while teaching them realistic ways to help children keep their own rights and guard the rights of others in the cyber-sphere.

Each presentation is 90 minutes.

Adults who are new employees or volunteers should attend CAP 1 before attending CAP 2 or CAP 3. After five years, adults have the option of attending CAP 1, 2 or 3 when they renew their CAP.
