Dear Parents and Guardians,

Plans are underway for the 2018-2019 school year. As you know, the tuition charged does not cover the cost of educating each child which is approximately \$6525.00. Along with the fundraising efforts of our Advancement Committee and PTA, Our Lady of Peace Parish makes tremendous investments to support the school in operational expenses as well as academic programs and is thereby helping to lower your tuition costs. As per the Bishop's Report: A Plan for Catholic Schools in the Diocese of Camden, the parish continues to support the school through the Interparochial Catholic School Fund (ICFS). This fund will support all Catholic Schools in the diocese thus our parish subsidy will continue to increase for the upcoming school year. Our Lady of Peace Parish contributed \$145,428.00 for the current school year. That dollar amount will increase for the 2018-2019 school year. The percentage of tuition increase has been determined by the diocese. **We will continue the practice of not charging additional fees.** We will also increase the amount of tuition assistance that we will make available in our budget. We distributed \$128,000 to our families for the 2017-2018 school year. Therefore, tuition will increase \$200 for the first child (\$20 per month). There will be an increase of \$150 for the second child (\$15 per month). The third+ child increase will be \$125 (\$12.50 per month). The Non-Catholic rate will increase by \$250 (\$25.00) per month.

Tuition rates for 2018-2019 school year:

Catholic Students:

- 1st child - \$5250.00
- 2nd child - \$4050.00
- 3rd child (and each additional child) - \$3250.00

Non-Catholic Students:

- \$6525.00 per child

It is important to us that our school families get first priority to reregister. We have had many Open Houses and will continue to offer them. There has been interest from many new families

to enroll in our school at all grade levels. Therefore please be sure to reserve your child a seat by returning the reregistration form as soon as possible. Tuition assistance is still available through FACTS Tuition Assistance and we encourage you to apply. You can log in through your FACTS account to apply. The 2018-2019 school year **tuition payments will begin in July and end in April.**

St. Mary School offers many opportunities for the children to grow not only academically, but spiritually, physically and emotionally. As always we will continue to provide the best education possible to your child/children. This education that you generously give to your child is an investment in his/her future as they become the leaders of the future.

We can be sure that we love God's children when we love God and do what He has commanded. 1 John 5:2

The Office of Child and Youth Protection is announcing CAP (Child Assault Prevention) sessions. CAP is the safe environment training program for adults who have regular contact with minors. Attendance is required in order to comply with the USCCB's *Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People*. The policy of the Diocese of Camden is that adults will attend CAP once every five years.

CAP 1 teaches attendees to **recognize child abuse and neglect** and how to report to the proper authorities. Adults are taught that children have the right to be safe, strong and free. CAP 1 is for new volunteers and employees.

CAP 2 is called **CAP's Bullying Prevention Program** and is a workshop addressing bullying awareness and bullying prevention. Cyber-bullying is also presented.

CAP 3 is called **Cyber-Empowerment** and is a workshop which promotes adults understanding of cyber activity of youth while teaching them realistic ways to help children keep their own rights and guard the rights of others in the cyber-sphere.

Each presentation is 90 minutes.

Adults who are new employees or volunteers should attend CAP 1 before attending CAP 2 or CAP 3. After five years, adults have the option of attending CAP 1, 2 or 3 when they renew their CAP.
