Dear Parents and Guardians,

Welcome Back! I hope that you were able to find the time to rest and relax during these hot summer days! The children appear eager and ready to get started!

Miss Mariela Cifuentes our Instrumental Music Director, from Northeastern Music Programs, will be with us again this year. On Monday, students in grades 4-8 will briefly meet with Miss Cifuentes to learn more about the program. There will be a new band parent meeting on Monday, September 16th at 7PM in the science lab.

Miss Jessica Smith will be back with us again this year as our full time counselor. She will be working with classes and holding large and small group sessions on a variety of topics. Her email address is counselor@smarys.org if you need to contact her.

Our Back to School Nights are scheduled for grades K-4 on Wednesday, September 11th and grades 5-8 on Wednesday, September 18th. Door will open at 6:30PM. Our evening will follow the same format as last year. Prayer will begin in Assumption Hall at 7PM. We will then ask you to go to your child's homeroom. While in homeroom we will utilize our closed circuit television system to bring you our special announcements. Teachers will then provide you with information regarding their class and expectations.

Our Opening Liturgy will be on Wednesday, September 18th at 9:15. At this time we will install the Ministers of Student Leadership. We will continue to offer our Science Explorers Club this year to students in grades 1-5 and it will be directed by Mr. Wolf. It is a hands-on after school club which will enhance a child's love of all things science. There is a fee involved for the various topics that will be offered. The flyers were sent home today. We will kick it off with an assembly scheduled for September 12th.

Applications for the National Free and Reduced Lunch Program are now due. The application was emailed to each school family during the summer and can be found on our school website. Hard copies are also being sent home today in Communication Folders.

Just a reminder for those who pick up their children at dismissal: Please do not park on Carroll Ave. for pick up. The street is too busy and can be a safety hazard. Please park in the lot and stand by the Parish Center. The children will only be dismissed from that area.

RenWeb is our student information system. You will be able to access your child's grades and report cards through this portal. Homework will be sent to you through email or Remind from your child's teacher. I encourage you to be in contact with your child's teacher with any questions or concerns you may have. We would like to work together with you to make this year a great one for your family!

For the safety of our school and to eliminate traffic in our office, we have a large drop box outside the front doors to the office. It will be unlocked from 8:00 am - 3:00 pm each day. This drop box will be for forgotten lunches, books, supplies, clothes, etc. It will be checked throughout the day. Please be sure all items are labeled with your child's full name and homeroom.

I am looking forward to our new year! Be sure to look for our first day of school pictures on Facebook. If you have not liked our page, please do so! You can access our Facebook Page from the front page of our website. The building looks great, the teachers are excited, and the children are ready to learn! Traffic Patterns for AM drop off and PM dismissal

<u>Car Safety</u> - It is extremely important that all cars travel slowly at any time of the day when traveling in the school parking lot. Below you will find traffic patterns for the morning and the afternoon. Please follow outlined procedures for the safety of all our children.

Morning Drop Off – Students may begin to arrive by car at 7:50 am. Please drop students off by the 8th grade doors. Parents/guardians please stay in your cars and have students on left side for easy exit from your car. Teachers and safeties will be there to greet and assist you. NO DROP OFFS ARE PERMITTED ON CARROLL AVE.

Afternoon-Pick-Up: Dismissal begins at 2:45 pm. Parents/guardians are to park in the main lot and walk over to the dismissal area. Please do not exit near buses. You will need to exit on Carroll Ave after all car riders are dismissed. NO PICK UP'S ARE PERMITTED ON CARROLL AVE.

We are instituting these procedures for the safety of your child and yourself. It is very important that you do not park on Carroll Ave. during drop off or pick up times.

Also you must write a note to your child's teacher if you have a dismissal change for your child. If you need to call the main office for a dismissal change you must do so before 1:00 pm. Thank you!


Accessing ParentsWeb





Scrip fundraising is a no-selling program that enables families to raise money for their non-profit organization (NPO). Scrip is just another way to pay for everyday purchases using gift cards in place of cash, checks, and credit cards.

You purchase gift cards from your organization at face value, and your coordinator orders those cards from Great Lakes Scrip Center at a reduced price. The difference is an instant rebate for your organization. It's really that simple!

Orders can be sent into school with your child and in most cases, are filled the same day. We usually have Shop Rite, Wawa, Walmart, Target and Kohl's daily. All other cards are ordered on Tuesday and sent home Thursday.

Rebates are issued twice a year to families, in January and June. They can be used to reduce tuition or as a rebate to the family directly.

I encourage you to check out <u>www.shopwithscrip.com</u>. There you can see a full list of retailers or register for an online account. Online orders come to me directly.



ORDERING

Students have a choice of six entrees each day. They are:

- 1. The today's special the regular
- 2. An alternate lunch
- 3. Salad lunch (Monday-Wednesday-Friday only)
- 4. Chicken Nuggets
- 5. Peanut & Jelly Sandwich
- 6. Cereal & Yogurt

*Each lunch comes with all of the daily components to make a balanced meal. These sides are listed on the menu under the lunch choices.

SERVICE

The Offer vs. Serve program is in place at the school. Students have the option to choose all five components of the lunch, or to take at least three. In this program, children are not required to take an item if they absolutely do not want that item.

SELECTION

Ala Carte items are available daily. Students will have an opportunity to purchase healthy snacks after they finish eating lunch.


