### **IMPORTANT INFORMATION TO KNOW PRIOR TO YOUR IN-PERSON TOUR:**

St. Mary School has guidelines in place for in-person tours all for the safety and well-being of you, our students, Faculty and staff here at St. Mary School.

#### **We please ask:**

1- All those coming for the tour will be required to wear a mask (please no gaiters or scarves), covering mouth and nose, during the duration of the tour. We must also maintain the 6 feet social distancing requirement.

2-If anyone planning to attend the tour is feeling sick, we ask that we reschedule when everyone is feeling well. Students are welcome to attend the in-person tours.

3-Bathrooms **WILL NOT** be available for use.

4-We ask all of our guests to please use hand sanitizer upon arrival (we will have it on hand) and temperatures will be taken of all those who enter our building.

5- We will have limited accessibility to classrooms. We will also be visiting our gym, Computer Lab, Science Lab, Library and Advanced Math classroom. We cannot guarantee we will be able to enter a classroom.

6-We have limited the time for each tour to 15 minutes in order for us to clean in between.

7- You will have the opportunity to ask questions along the way during the tour. If you have additional questions we will be able to set-up a time for you to contact our principal. In order to be sure we give each of our attendees the full time of the tour, we ask that you please arrive on-time for your tour.

8-We ask please, if anyone in your group becomes ill (diagnosed with Covid-19) following your tour, to please contact Jackie Kern at [advancementoffice@smarys.org](mailto:advancementoffice@smarys.org) as soon as possible.

9-We will ask all who attend to sign in and include contact information.

10-If you have travelled to any of the states or have hosted anyone from any of the states that New Jersey requires you to quarantine upon return, we ask that you please schedule your in-person tour to a later dates (TBD).
