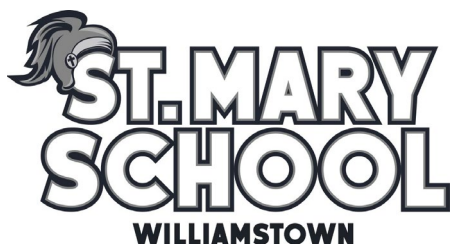


# Messages from the School Office

Dear Parents and Guardians,

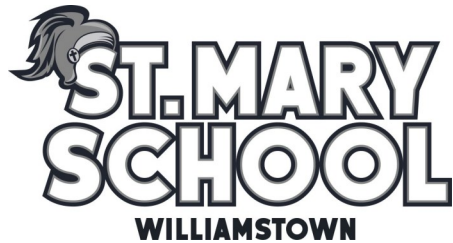

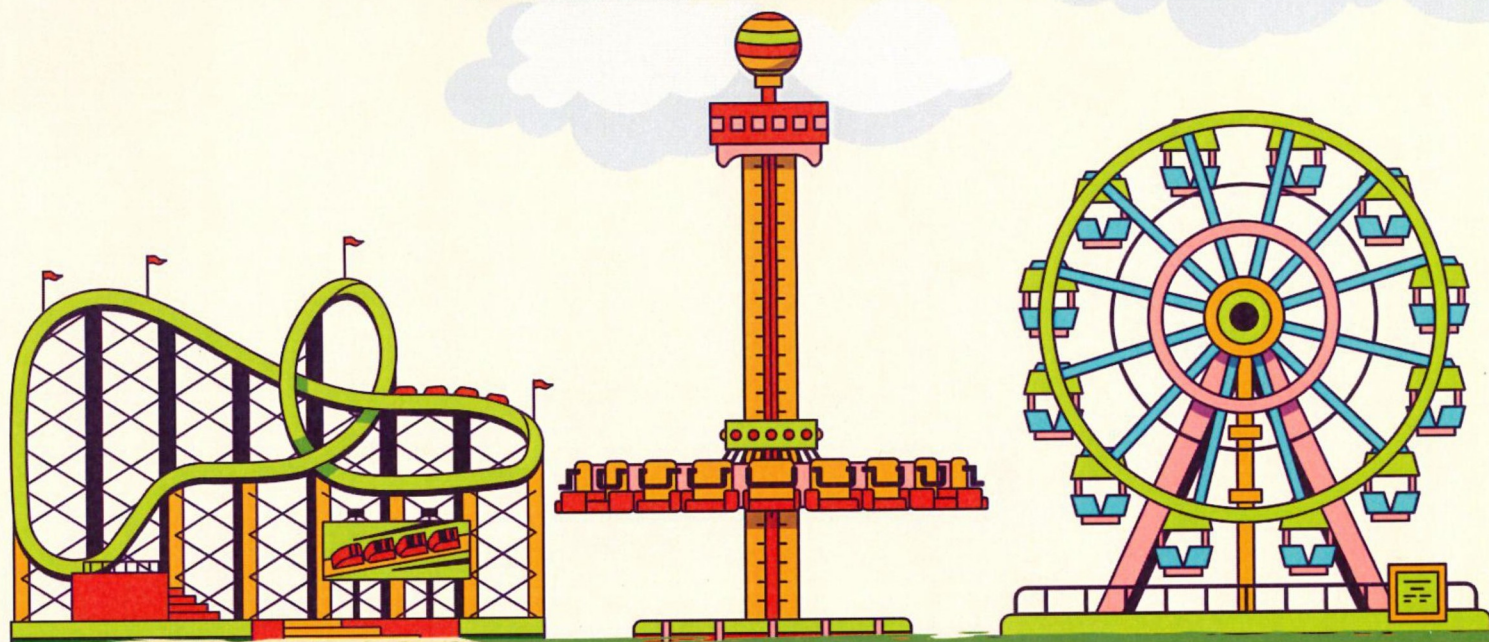
